- 1.) With you having previously given us some form of access into your home (ie: key, garage code, etc.) we will be happy to take your dog home to your home and there will be an additional charge of \$25 plus \$15 for the shuttle OR
- 2.) If you are not comfortable providing us with some form of access and you are not able to pick your dog up by 6:00 and you have not made previous arrangements, there will be an automatic charge of \$100 per night and your dog can be picked up from Paws In Time at 7:00 am the following regular business morning.

WAIVER, HOLD HARMLESS, RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

Pursuant to that agreement ("Agreement") dated _____, 20__ by and between Paws In Time and owner ("owner") of the animal named _____ ("animal") the owner hereby further agrees as follows:

AGREED:

1. I understand that there are risks with my dog while attending a day care facility and as owner I agree to be solely responsible for all acts and behaviors of the animal at any time during the term of this agreement, including any medical bills which may ensue for the behaviors of this animal, and in no case shall Paws In Time be liable for the animal's acts and behaviors other than for the exercise of gross negligence on the part of Paws In Time, its agents or employees, in the keeping of the animal.
2. That Paws In Time will exercise ordinary and responsible care of all of the animals under their care at all times but Paws In Time shall not be under any obligation to guard against injuries which it has no reason to expect on account of the disposition of an individual animal.
3. That the owner is familiar with the disposition of their animal and is aware of any mischievous or vicious propensities of their animal, including a disposition by their animal to bite, attack, scratch and otherwise injure or attempt to injure other animals or people.
4. Paws In Time shall not be liable and the owner releases Paws In Time for any damages or injuries to the animal arising out of or from the keeping of the animal or that may accrue from any cause whatsoever in connection with the keeping including theft, running away, loss by fire, injury or death while under the care of Paws In Time during the term of this agreement except where any such loss is caused by the neglect or intentional act of the corporation or by any of Paws In Time's agents or employees.
5. Owner shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Paws In Time, its agents and employees against all damages sustained by reason of the keeping of the animal for any claims or injuries whatsoever arising out of the keeping of the animal by Paws In Time.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is full day daycare? Full day daycare means your dog will be out playing with other dogs during our normal hours of operation of 7 am – 6 pm if you have brought him/her in for daycare. If your dog is boarding with us in either the kennels or the smaller spas, you **MUST** put your dog in full day daycare for the full price.

What is half day daycare? Half day daycare means your dog can be here to play **up to 5 hours**.

What happens when my dog boards with Paws In Time and is staying in a kennel or a spa? Your dog must be in full day daycare and you will be charged the price of ahte kennel AND the price of daycare for the full day. If you are currently on a pre-paid package of days, the days of daycare will be automatically deducted from your daycare package. Your dog will be playing with the other dogs and staff from 6 am Monday through Saturday until 5 pm. At this time, your dog will be put in their overnight accommodations and fed. They will stay in their kennel or spa room until 6 pm at which time they will be brought back out to the play floor and played with until 7:45 pm. At this time, they are put to bed, given a cookie and the lights are out in the building at 8 pm. Everyone leaves the building for the night. There is no one in the building.

What happens when my dog boards with Paws In Time and is staying in one of the suites? In the suites, you have the option of doing full day daycare or half day daycare. Full day is as above. Half day daycare is described above.

What happens here at Paws In Time on Sundays? On Sundays, staff is here from 6-8 am, 11-1 and 6-8 om to care for the boarding clients only. We are not here for the purpose of public daycare. If you dog is staying with us you are perfectly welcome to come in to pick him/her up during these times. We welcome you to do that. However, we do not allwo the drop off of boarding dogs on Sundays. There are NO EXEP-TIONS to this. If you are boarding with us, you are not charged for daycare but you are charged as any other night of the week.

Our focus here at Paws In Time is to provide your dog with a professional, safe, fun place to come to play for daycare. When you choose to have your dog stay with us while you travel, you have options of where they stay based on availability. Hopefully, this form will help you to understand what we are doing with your dog while they are here with us. If have read and understand this form.

Vaccination and Examination Options

We currently have a veterinarian on staff on a part time basis and are able to offer the following options:

- Vaccinations – if your dog (s) is not current on their vaccinations you may elect to have them receive their boosters while at Paws In Time. If you elect this option we will need to have information from your current veterinarian regarding any previous vaccinations reactions your dog may have had. For example your dog may have experienced hives (swelling around the face or of the body) following a previous vaccination. **At it's most serious, a reaction to a vaccination could cause anaphylaxis, which is life threatening.**

_____ I (We) elect to have the veterinarian on staff at Paws In Time give my dog (s) the required vaccinations while they are here. The state of Illinois requires that your dog be current on rabies, distemper and parvo virus within one year and the bordatella vaccination must be current within 6 months.

_____ I (We) elect **NOT** to have the veterinarian on staff at Paws In Time give my dog (s) their vaccinations. I understand that I am responsible for keeping the vaccinations up to date and must provide a current record of them to Paws In Time. If my dog should be found to not be current on their vaccinations they will not be welcome until the vaccinations are again current.

- Examination – if you are boarding your dog (s) **for more than 7 days** you have the option of having your dog examined by the veterinarian on staff during their stay. The charge for the examination is \$40 and if there is any treatment or medication necessary you will be responsible for any additional charges. You will receive a written explanation of any findings so you can provide your veterinarian with an update.

_____ I (We) elect to have the veterinarian on staff at Paws In Time perform a routine examination of my dog while he/she is boarding and I agree to pay the \$40 examination fee as well as any necessary charges associated with appropriate care.

_____ I (We) elect to **NOT** have the veterinarian on staff at Paws In Time perform a routine examination while he/she is boarding here. However, if my dog does get sick while boarding and requires a veterinarian:

_____ I agree to pay a transportation fee of \$25 for my dog to be taken to my veterinarian and will also pay all charges associated with the visit

Or

_____ I agree to pay the \$40 examination fee to the veterinarian on staff at Paws In Time as well as any costs associated with his/her treatment.

Vaccination and Examination Options

By virtue of the fact that Paws In Time is a daycare/boarding facility, I understand that in the course of a regular day of daycare my dog will be playing with other dogs and it is possible that **an injury could occur or behavior could be demonstrated that may indicate my dog is not feeling well**. As such, should the situation present itself that my dog requires immediate veterinary care, I realize that I have options.

_____ I (We) would prefer that staff at Paws In Time contact me using the following emergency contact number: _____. I will make the decision at that time to come pick my dog up and take him/her to my veterinarian for the necessary care.

_____ I (We) would prefer that staff at Paws In Time contact me using the following emergency contact number: _____ and we will discuss the injury or possible illness. If deemed necessary and if the veterinarian on staff is present at the time, I would elect to have her examine my dog and then discuss with me the possible options for care. If the veterinarian is not available then I will make the decision to either come get my dog or will pay the \$25 transportation fee to have my dog taken to my veterinarian.

We understand that through the regular course of our lives there may be times when we may not be able to reach you either because you are out of the country or are otherwise unreachable. If this situation should occur, I would prefer:

_____ I (We) have a designated emergency contact and they have my permission to make any decisions necessary.

_____ I (We) give Paws In Time my full authorization to care for my dog regardless of what needs to be done and I will reimburse Paws In Time for any costs incurred.
